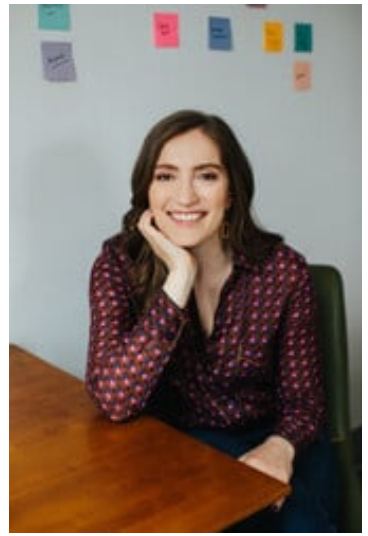
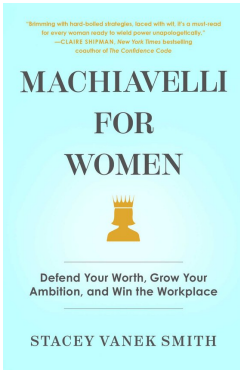


Stacey Vanek Smith
